Emergency Plan Document 2024

All major emergencies are dealt with by the emergency services, Local Authorities, Utilities and voluntary agencies in a combined response. In extreme circumstances such as heavy snow and flooding, there is a possibility that the emergency services may not be able to reach the scene immediately.

North Cadbury Village Hall is located at High St, North Cadbury, Yeovil BA22 7DP

Facilities

The main hall is 14m x 8m and is capable of housing up to 200 people standing or 100 with full table seating. There is a raised stage area of 5.7m x 10m.

The hall has a kitchen with full cooking facilities, toilets and a disabled toilet which has baby changing facilities.

There is a further meeting room (the Reading Room) that can seat up to 50 people. This has a small kitchen area for making drinks.

The hall is Wi-Fi enabled along with a projection and sound system.

The carpark is small but capable of holding 15 cars.

There is a defibrillator on the exterior wall of the village hall.
