

Yarlington Village Hall, Emergency Plan

Introduction:

All major emergencies are dealt with by emergency services, Local Authority services, utilities, and other voluntary organisations in a combined response. In extreme circumstances, for example, heavy snow, or flooding there is a possibility that the emergency services will not be able to reach the community with immediate effect, and therefore strategies need to be in place.

Facilities:

The main hall is approximately 5m by 10m and has the capacity to hold 50 people. The hall has a toilet with disabled access, a fully operational catering kitchen with electric cooker, tables and chairs, electric heating and is wi-fi connected.

In addition, there is parking for 7 cars on both the tarmac apron to the front of the hall and on the drive to the side of the patio. In fine dry weather, a few more cars can park on the grass with access via the five bar gate.

The entrance to the village hall will remain clear for emergency vehicles.

The village has one defibrillator and this can be found 100m further down the road in the telephone box on the left just before the junction
