Parish Ranger Scheme

South Somerset District Council's Parish Ranger can take care of your additional maintenance work. We have listed the types of work we cover but bespoke arrangements can be made to suit your needs.

Parish Ranger Scheme: What does the Scheme offer?

A high standard of works that are beyond the scope of normal maintenance regimes and unique work that falls outside of routine responsibilities.

This includes: horticultural works / cutting back of overgrowth / bulb and tree planting, management of environmental and conservation areas, providing additional clearance of flood alleviation / drainage systems, additional litter clearance, installation / repairs to fences and gates, additional herbicide applications and additional clearance of street weeds.

Who is responsible for the Parish Ranger?

South Somerset District Council's Environment Services Team manage the day to day work of the Ranger and their health & safety and training responsibilities.

Who decides on the Rangers' work plan?

An annual work programme of routine tasks is agreed with the Parish prior to commencement of the scheme and circulated to all members for clarity.

The Ranger is trained to undertake: conservation management / herbicide application / minor arboricultural works / minor landscaping and countryside building skills / cleansing operations.

When required additional skills can be called upon depending on the project, these can include: major arboricultural works including tree risk and inspection / open space risk assessment / open space design and management.

How much does the scheme cost?

There is an hourly rate of £19.50 per hour+vat.
