

North Cadbury and Yarlington Parish Council Rights of Way Report – March 2021

Outstanding Issues

- WN 19/1 (Smallway Lane east) access overgrown, broken stile, no finger post. No access at junction with Frog Lane no stile or way marking. ROW officer aware. Not a priority at this time. (Has been an issue since before Sept. 2019)
- WN 19/2 Fingerpost down. (Reported Dec. 2020)
- WN 19/78 ROW officer has agreed to replace gate at southern entrance to this footpath.
- WN 31/7 Tree down and foliage blocking path. (Reported July 2020)
- WN 19/105 Paul Longman has agreed in principle to installation of bollards. Rob Coate is awaiting meeting to finalise siting.
- WN 19/103 Finger post down. (Reported Jan. 2021)
- WN 19/95 Bridge to be re-built.
- WN19/27 Maize harvested but crop for sheep fodder sown. No path. Landowner unknown.
- WN 22/16 Maize harvested but path not reinstated. Landowner unknown.
- Manor Farm Route through farmyard at the end of Sleight Lane Track is confusing for walkers. PPLO and ROW officer are considering how to place waymarks more effectively.
- WN 19/91 Exit to Woolston Road continues to be unofficially diverted. Electric fence has been erected around field. Unprotected wire crosses unofficial stile. (Reported summer 2020 and again directly to ROW officer Feb. 2001)
- WN 19/74 Gate mechanism at Cary Rd. end is very stiff.
- WN 19/65 ROW has been unofficially diverted for many months. (Reported Feb. 2001)

Circular walks project

Sites for display board at Galhampton still uncertain. PPLO has received prototype of large map showing all the ROW in parish. PPLO is in process of highlighting individual circular walks.
